Re: Safety During Construction of the New School at Robert Moore

Student, staff and community safety is of utmost concern at all times and especially so during the construction of our new school.

Safety procedures will be reviewed and adjusted continuously during the construction process.

All students, staff and community members are asked to stay well away from the construction zone and equipment. This expectation applies at all times—both during and outside of school hours. All reports of breaches to this requirement will be dealt with through the school office. Please reinforce this critical safety need with your children.

To accommodate the reduction in playground, and yet provide adequate play space, student break times have been staggered to allow for fewer students to be using the available grounds. Also, the south east section of the school property fronting on Second Street will be fenced to allow for some additional space for students.

In some situations indoor recess may be provided (like we do now during extreme weather).
